## 3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder must not clear more than 16.1248 hectares of native vegetation and 41 trees/shrubs within the combined areas shaded yellow on attached Plan 3731/7a, Plan 3731/7b, Plan 3731/7c, Plan 3731/7d, Plan 3731/7f, Plan 4751/7f, Pla

## 4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

## 5. Type of clearing authorised

This Permit authorises the Permit Holder to clear native vegetation for activities to the extent that the Permit Holder has the power to clear native vegetation for those activities under the *Local Government Act 1995* or any other written law.

## 6. Compliance with Assessment Sequence and Management Procedures

Prior to clearing any native vegetation under conditions 1, 2 and 3 of this Permit, the Permit Holder must comply with the Assessment Sequence and the Management Procedures set out in Part II of this Permit.

## PART II - ASSESSMENT SEQUENCE AND MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES

## 7. Avoid, minimise etc clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the authorised purpose of this Permit, the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

#### 8. Weed control

Prior to undertaking any clearing or other activity authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds:

- (a) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
- (b) ensure that no weed-affected soil, mulch, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
- (c) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.

## 9. Offset - Site 1 - Conservation

In relation to the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 3731/7k, the Permit Holder shall provide to the CEO a copy of the management order issued to the Permit Holder for the purpose of "Public Recreation and Conservation".

## 10. Offset - Site 2 - Conservation

In relation to the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 3731/71, the Permit Holder shall:

- (a) prior to 31 December 2018, provide evidence from the Department of Lands that a management order will be issued to the Permit Holder for the purpose of "Public Recreation and Conservation".
- (b) provide to the CEO a copy of the management order no later than 31 December 2019.

## 11. Offset - Site 3 - Revegetation

The Permit Holder shall establish and maintain at least 3.1 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched red on attached Plan 3731/7m in accordance with the following conditions:

- (a) the Permit Holder shall develop completion criteria for that area and submit those criteria to the CEO for the CEO's approval prior to 30 June 2016;
- (b) the Permit Holder shall implement the completion criteria approved by the CEO; and
- (c) vegetation establishment must commence no later than 30 June 2017.

## PART III - RECORD KEEPING AND REPORTING

## 12. Records must be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit:

- (a) In relation to the clearing of native vegetation authorised under this Permit:
  - the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit set to Geocentric Datum Australia 1994 (GDA94), expressing the geographical coordinates in Eastings and Northings or decimal degrees;
  - (ii) the date that the area was cleared; and
  - (iii) the size of the area cleared (in hectares).
- (b) In relation to the offset of areas pursuant to condition 11:
  - the location of any area of offsets recorded using a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit set to Geocentric Datum Australia 1994 (GDA94), expressing the geographical coordinates in Eastings and Northings or decimal degrees;
  - (ii) a description of the offset activities undertaken;
  - (iii) the size of the offset area (in hectares); and
  - (iv) the species composition, structure and density of the area of offsets.

## 13. Reporting

- (a) The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records required under condition 12 of this Permit and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
- (b) Prior to 19 June 2022 the permit holder must provide to the CEO a written report of records required under condition 12 of this Permit where these records have not already been provided under condition 13(a) of this Permit.

## Definitions

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

fill means material used to increase the ground level, or fill a hollow;

mulch means the use of organic matter, wood chips or rocks to slow the movement of water across the soil surface and to reduce evaporation;

weed/s means any plant -

- (a) that is a declared pest under section 22 of the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007; or
- (b) published in a Department of Parks and Wildlife Regional Weed Rankings Summary, regardless of ranking; or
- (c) not indigenous to the area concerned.

## 2. Site Information

## 2.1. Existing environment and information

## 2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

#### Vegetation Description

Beard vegetation association 6 is described as medium woodland; tuart and jarrah (Shepherd et al 2001).

Heddle vegetation complex Karrakatta Central and South is described as predominantly open forest of Eucalyptus gomphocephala (Tuart) -Eucalyptus marginata (Jarrah) -Corymbia calophylla (Marri) and woodland of Eucalyptus marginata (Jarrah) - Banksia species (Heddle et al 1980).

## Clearing Description

The amended application is to clear 16.1248 hectares and 41 trees/shrubs within various reserves and properties for the purpose of road upgrades, relocation of a golf tee, and hazard reduction (asbestos removal).

## **Vegetation Condition**

Very Good: Vegetation structure altered: obvious signs of disturbance (Keighery 1994).

To

Completely Degraded: Vegetation structure no longer intact; completely/almost completely without native species (Keighery 1994).

## Comment

The vegetation condition was determined through aerial imagery and photos provided by the applicant (City of Wanneroo 2015).

The vegetation description and condition as described relates to the additional application area of 0.0948 hectares and 13 native shrubs. For the vegetation description and condition of remaining application areas refer to clearing permit Decision Reports CPS 3731/1, CPS 3731/2, CPS 3731/4 and CPS 3731/6.

## 3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

#### Comments

The City of Wanneroo has applied to amend clearing permit CPS 3731/6 to modify the approved permit area to allow for additional clearing of 0.0948 hectares of native vegetation and 13 native shrubs for road works along Wesco Road and at the intersection of Lenore Road and Nicholas Road. The City has also applied to extend the permit duration by five years.

The additional areas applied for under CPS 3731/7 comprise three main locations:

- Area 1 contains 13 Xanthorrhoea preissii (City of Wanneroo 2015) and is located at the western end of the proposed works on Wesco Road near Hopkins Road (Lot 502 on Plan 71509);
- Area 2 is 0.0944 hectares and is located at the eastern end of the proposed works on Wesco Road near Telephone Road (Lot 505 on Plan 71510); and
- Area 3 is 0.0004 hectares, contains five plants (Acacia saligna, Hakea prostrata, Allocasuarina fraseriana, Xanthorrhoea preissii and Banksia prionotes) (City of Wanneroo 2015) and is located at the intersection of Lenore Road and Nicholas Road (PIN 11909697, 11751758, 11909700, 11564908, 11751759, and 11909703).

Based on the information supplied with the application (City of Wanneroo 2015) and a review of aerial imagery, Areas 1 and 3 are both in completely degraded (Keighery 1994) condition and are not considered to contain significant environmental values.

A flora and fauna assessment (Coffey Environments 2009) was previously commissioned by the City of Wanneroo for the length of Wesco Road between Hopkins Road and Old Yanchep Road to support the original clearing permit application CPS 3731/1. The assessment evaluated a study area equivalent to 30 metres either side of Wesco Road. Area 2 is located within the study area being approximately 10 to 20 metres north of Wesco Road and near the intersection with Telephone Road.

The flora and fauna assessment determined that the vegetation condition in the vicinity of Area 2 ranged from good to very good (Keighery 1994) (Coffey Environments 2009). The vegetation at this location was described as "Low Closed Forest to Low Open Forest of Eucalyptus marginata, Banksia attenuata, Banksia menziessii and Nuytsia floribunda to 9m over Shrubland of Xanthorrhoea preissii, Macrozamia riedlei and Stirlingia latifolia to 1.3m over Low Shrubland Hibbertia hypericoides, Gompholobium tomentosum, Xanthorrhoea gracilis, Bossiaea eriocarpa and Hypocalymma robustum to 0.8m" (Coffey Environments 2009). A Floristic Community Type (FCT) analysis (Gibson et al 1994) determined that the vegetation type most closely resembled FCTs 28 and 21a (Coffey Environments 2009). Neither of these FCTs are listed by the WA Department of Parks and Wildlife or under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 as Threatened or Priority Ecological Communities.

The flora and fauna assessment did not identify any conservation significant flora within the study area (Coffey Environments 2009). The proposed clearing of Area 2 is not considered likely to result in significant impacts to conservation significant flora.

The proposed clearing of Area 2 is not considered likely to result in significant impacts to fauna habitat, significant remnant vegetation, watercourses, wetlands or surface and groundwater quality given the size and location of clearing. The proposed clearing of Area 2 is also not considered likely to cause appreciable land degradation or cause or exacerbate the incidence or intensity of flooding.

Area 2 is located within Bush Forever site 293 and adjoins the Gnangara-Moore River State Forest. Therefore the proposed clearing may result in impacts to conservation areas. However, it is considered that such impacts can be appropriately addressed through existing weed management permit conditions.

The original assessment of the application (CPS 3731/1) determined that the proposed clearing was at variance to principles (a), (b), (f) and (h), may be at variance to principles (c) and (g), and was not likely to be at variance to the remaining principles. Given the assessment of the additional application areas outlined above, the assessment against the clearing principles has not changed.

## Planning instruments and other relevant matters.

#### Comments

A number of amendments to CPS 3731 have previously been made and a summary of the permit history is as follows:

- On 19 August 2010 CPS 3731/1 was granted for the clearing of 14.09 hectares of native vegetation including:
  - 0.4 hectares of native vegetation in degraded to very good (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Wesco Road;
  - 3 hectares of native vegetation in degraded to pristine (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Old Yanchep Road;
  - 6.6 hectares of native vegetation in degraded to very good (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Flynn Drive;
  - 4 hectares of native vegetation in completely degraded to excellent (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Lenore Road/Franklin Road;
  - 0.05 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Evandale Road; and
  - 0.04 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for relocation of a golf tee at Carramar Golf Club.
- On 16 December 2010 CPS 3731/2 was granted for the clearing of an additional 22 trees/shrubs and 0.68 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Joondalup Drive and Lyndavale Loop.
- On 14 September 2011 an application to amend CPS 3731/2 was declined (CPS 3731/3) as the location of additional clearing proposed was not supplied.
- On 1 December 2011 CPS 3731/4 was granted for the clearing of an additional 1.072 hectares of native vegetation and 6 trees/shrubs including:
  - 0.03 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Wesco Road:
  - 0.1 hectares of native vegetation in good (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Flynn Drive;
  - 0.8 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Lenore Road/Franklin Road;
  - 0.03 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Evandale Road;
  - 0.07 hectares of native vegetation in good (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Hester Avenue; and
  - 6 trees/shrubs and 0.042 hectares of native vegetation in degraded to excellent (Keighery 1994) condition for road works at Hepburn Avenue.
- On 9 February 2012 an administrative amendment was made to correct the properties listed on the permit (CPS 3731/5).
- On 21 February 2013 CPS 3731/6 was granted for the clearing of an additional 0.2 hectares of native vegetation in degraded (Keighery 1994) condition for asbestos removal works.

CPS 3731/1 included an offset condition (condition 10) which required the City of Wanneroo to submit an offset proposal for approval prior to clearing. The offset was required due to impacts to the following:

- Priority Ecological Communities:
- Vegetation in good (Keighery 1994) condition or better that provides significant habitat for fauna including foraging habitat for Carnaby's cockatoo;
- Vegetation growing in association with conservation and resource enhancement category wetlands;
- Bush Forever sites.

On 4 November 2010, an offset proposal was approved under condition 10 of CPS 3731/1 that included:

- Conservation of approximately 41 hectares of remnant vegetation and wetland, and revegetation of approximately 15 hectares of degraded land, at Lake Badgerup; and
- Conservation of two parcels of land totalling approximately nine hectares at Banksia Grove.

The approved offset proposal also addressed the requirements of offset conditions 8, 9 and 9 of the City of Wanneroo's clearing permits CPS 1964/2, CPS 2184/3 and CPS 2963/1 respectively. The offset was approved on the basis of a 2:1 offset/clearing ratio and a breakdown of the offset allocation for each permit is provided in the table below.

The approved offset proposal was amended on 30 November 2010 with the amendments relating to the manner in which the offset sites would be secured and managed for conservation.

No additional offsets were required for amendments CPS 3731/2, CPS 3731/4 or CPS 3731/6.

A review of the implementation status of the approved offset proposal has been undertaken. The City of Wanneroo has advised that a total of 10.821 hectares of revegetation at Lake Badgerup has been undertaken to date with a remaining area of approximately 4.3 hectares yet to be completed (City of Wanneroo 2015a). A management order has been issued to the City of Wanneroo for approximately 56 hectares at Lake Badgerup (Crown Reserve 43821) for the purpose of 'conservation', 'public recreation' and 'recreation'. A management order has also been issued to the City of Wanneroo for approximately 7.8 hectares of remnant vegetation at Banksia Grove (Lot 8027 on Plan 68523 - Crown Reserve 51098) for the purpose of 'conservation' and 'public recreation'. A management order has yet to be issued to the City of Wanneroo for an additional 1.2 hectares of remnant vegetation at Banksia Grove.

The review has identified that the locations of revegetation at Lake Badgerup, and of the 1.2 hectare land parcel at Banksia Grove, have been subject to minor changes since the original offset assessment. Given these changes, an assessment of the suitability of each amended offset location has been undertaken. The assessment identified that the suitability/environmental values of each amended location are consistent with the suitability/environmental values of the original assessed locations. However, amendments are required to the revegetation completion criteria for Lake Badgerup. The offset condition on the permit has been amended to accurately reflect current offset requirements.

No public submissions were received in relation to the application.
