The amended boundary will increase the permit area by 194.1ha. This new boundary and clearing total will accommodate mine designs approved in the most recent environmental group site Mining Proposal for the Porphyry Project (RegID96583). Timing of clearing will align with the planned mining schedule. Cleared areas will be rehabilitated in line with the approved closure plan with a final land use being predominantly pastoral. With recommencement of the Porphyry Project, the mine design was reviewed to ensure additional activities, wherever possible, use existing disturbed areas. Where this has not been possible, landforms such as the Maingays WRD have been designed with specifications (e.g. 10° batter angles) aimed at increasing the success of rehabilitation and end land use objectives for Pastoral activities. Key stakeholder, Edjudina Pastoral Station was consulted during this process to ensure landform design would satisfy end land use outcomes.
