



Application for a clearing permit (area permit)

Environmental Protection Act 1986 s 51E

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Part 1 Land details

The land where clearing is proposed must be accurately described.

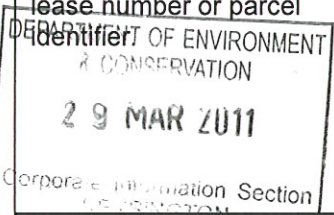

An aerial photograph or map must be attached, clearly marking the area proposed to clear and include Geographic latitude/longitude or Eastings and Northings.

 - Coordinate System: GCS GDA 1994 (Geographic latitude/longitude)

Purpose of clearing

The purpose for this clearing permit is for the building of a skate park within an area of Lot 437. The skate park foot print will be 437 square meters. This site will require the removal of 19 saplings and 6 pole sized trees (no veteran trees are proposed for removal) and the relocation of several grass trees.

There will be some thinning of vegetation adjacent to Jarrahdale road to enhance the passive surveillance from this road.

There will be a need to remove 4 saplings for the creation and safety of the pathway network within the vegetated area.

Part 3 Applicant

To apply for a permit you must either be:

- The owner of the land;
 - Acting on the owner's behalf; or
 - Likely to become the owner of the land.
- Note: If you are not the landowner, you must attach a letter of authority explicitly stating that you, the applicant, has authority to clear on the said land.
