LAND ON WHICH CLEARING IS TO BE DONE

Road reserve 0164 (Coorow Latham Road, the length connecting the junction of Coorow-Latham and Lampard-Tremlett roads to the junction of Coorow-Latham and Chapman roads).

AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

- 1. Clearing of up to 9 native trees within the area shaded yellow on attached Plan 430/2-1, Plan 430/2-2, Plan 430/2-3, Plan 430/2-4 & Plan 430/2-5.
- 2. Clearing of up to 0.005 hectares of native vegetation within the area shaded yellow on attached Plan 430/2-1, Plan 430/2-2, Plan 430/2-3, Plan 430/2-4 & Plan 430/2-5.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The permit holder shall revegetate 1 hectare of land as shaded red on Plan 430/2-2. The revegetation shall be established and maintained to an average planting density of a minimum of 1000 plants per hectare. The species shall consist of overstorey, midstorey and understorey species that are native to the area. Seed shall be sourced from within a 37km radius of the property.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall ensure the clearing is conducted by a person holding a Certificate III in Horticulture (Arboriculture), recognised by the Australia Qualifications Framework (AQF), with at least five years of practical experience in tree felling in Western Australia.
