AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 200 hectares for the purposes of mining.

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to condition 2, clearing of native vegetation within those tenements identified in the permit which have not been subject to flora and fauna surveys, is not authorised under this permit until:
 - a. The permit holder has submitted to the Chief Executive Officer:
 - i. evidence that establishes that the results of the flora and fauna surveys conducted on other land within the Davyhurst area are applicable to the areas that have not been subject to such surveys; or
 - ii. Evidence that flora and fauna studies have been undertaken in relation to the above tenement areas;
 - b. The Chief Executive Officer, having considered any information provided under subclause (a) determines that the clearing (or any part of it) can be implemented having regard to the objects of the Act and the matters referred to in section 51O of the Act; and
 - c. The permit holder receives written notification of the Chief Executive Officer's determination under subclause (b) that the clearing (or any part of it) may proceed.
2. Notwithstanding condition 1, the permit holder may commence clearing of up to 8 hectares of native vegetation for the purpose of widening an existing access track to facilitate the movement of mine vehicles between the Federal Flag/Walhalla mine and Davyhurst.
