

2. Site Information

2.1. Existing environment and information

2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

Vegetation Description

The area under application is mapped as being composed of the following vegetation types:

- Beard vegetation association 968: Medium woodland; jarrah, marri & wandoo (Shepherd, 2009).

- Heddle complex **FORRESTFIELD** COMPLEX: Vegetation ranges from open forest of Corymbia calophylla (Marri) - Eucalyptus wandoo (Wandoo) -Eucalyptus marginata (Jarrah) to open forest of Eucalyptus marginata (Jarrah) - Corymbia calophylla (Marri) -Allocasuarina fraseriana (Sheoak) - Banksia species. Fringing woodland of Eucalyptus rudis (Flooded Gum) in the gullies that dissect this landform (Mattiske and Havel 1998).

Clearing Description

The proponent wishes to clear 0.032 hectares for the purpose of constructing an outdoor education facility.

Vegetation Condition

Good: Structure significantly altered by multiple disturbance; retains basic structure/ability to regenerate (Keighery 1994)

Comment

The condition and description of the vegetation under application was determined via the use of aerial imagery (Swan Coastal Plain Central - Landgate 2010).

3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

Comments

The proposed clearing area consists of 0.032ha of native vegetation within a 0.25ha footprint area for the purpose of developing an outdoor education facility.

Given the small area proposed to be cleared it is unlikely that it will comprise a high level of biodiversity, contain significant fauna habitat, nor will it negatively impact groundwater, surfacewater quality or cause appreciable land degradation in the local area. Therefore the application is not likely to be at variance to any of

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the clearing principles.
