LAND ON WHICH CLEARING IS TO BE DONE

Road Reserve along Carnarvon - Mullewa Road

AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 80 hectares for the purposes of constructing a temporary bypass road.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
2. The Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill all plant species that are not native vegetation prior to the commencement of revegetation activities within the cleared site.
3. After completing the works required under condition 2, the Permit Holder shall:
 - a) Rip the soil to a depth between 50mm and 100mm; and
 - b) Lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained under condition 1 of this permit to an even depth on the soil as brushing material.
3. The Permit Holder shall complete the site preparation and brushing required under condition 2 and 3 by 16 October 2010.
5. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation from the Gascoyne River and the area within 50m of the Gascoyne River.
6. The Permit Holder shall not clear more than 25m in width.
