Road Reserve along Carnarvon - Mullewa Road

AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 80 hectares for the purposes of constructing a temporary bypass road.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill all plant species that are not native vegetation prior to the commencement of revegetation activities within the cleared site.
- 3. After completing the works required under condition 2, the Permit Holder shall:a) Rip the soil to a depth between 50mm and 100mm; andb) Lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained under condition 1 of this permit to an
 - b) Lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained under condition 1 of this permit to an even depth on the soil as brushing material.
- 3. The Permit Holder shall complete the site preparation and brushing required under condition 2 and 3 by 16 October 2010.
- 5. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation from the Gascoyne River and the area within 50m of the Gascoyne River.
- 6. The Permit Holder shall not clear more than 25m in width.
