Purpose of clearing

For the installation of a goat proof fence. Much of the fence is in place however varies in its state of repair. Some sections will need to be completely replaced and other areas only need minor repairs. The fence will be placed in a ~6m corridor of clearing enbabling access to install/repair the fence. The fence is part of an offset agreement for a project that Sinosteel is undertaking in the area which has been discussed and agreed with the DEC.

The installation of the fence and subsequent removal of goats (part of the agreement) will ensure the recovery/preservation of vegetation within the fenced area.
