The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

## PART I - CLEARING AUTHORISED

## 1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purpose of constructing a solid and liquid waste handling facility, access road and turning lanes.

## 2. Land on which clearing is to be done

Lot 609 on Deposited Plan 66691 (COOYA POOYA 6714) Warlu Way road reserve PIN 11997365 (COOYA POOYA 6714)

## 3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder must not clear more than 11.5 hectares of native vegetation within the area hatched vellow on attached Plan 4842/2.

## 4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

## PART II - MANAGEMENT CONDITIONS

#### Weed control

When undertaking any clearing or other activity authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds:

- (a) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
- (b) ensure that no weed-affected soil, mulch, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
- (c) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.

## DEFINITIONS

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

fill means material used to increase the ground level, or fill a hollow;

mulch means the use of organic matter, wood chips or rocks to slow the movement of water across the soil surface and to reduce evaporation; and

weed/s means any plant -

- (a) that is a declared pest under section 22 of the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007; or
- (b) published in a Department of Parks and Wildlife Regional Weed Summary, regardless of ranking; or
- (c) not indigenous to the area concerned.





## 2. Site Information

## 2.1. Existing environment and information

## 2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

#### **Vegetation Description**

Mapped Beard vegetation association 589 is described as Mosaic: Short bunch grassland - savanna / grass plain (Pilbara) / Hummock grasslands, grass steppe; soft spinifex (Shepherd et al 2001).

#### **Clearing Description**

The clearing consists of 11.5 hectares of native vegetation within Lot 609 on Deposited Plan 66691 and Warlu Way road reserve, Cooya Pooya, Shire of Roebourne, for the purpose of constructing a solid and liquid waste handling facility, access road and turning lanes.

#### Vegetation Condition

Very Good: Vegetation structure altered; obvious signs of disturbance (Keighery 1994)

#### Comment

The application is to increase the size of permit CPS 4842/1 by 1.5 hectares to a total of 11.5 hectares, for the addition of an access road and turning lanes.

The vegetation is in very good (Keighery 1994) condition.

The condition of the vegetation was determined through aerial imagery (Dampier and Extensions 50cm Orthomosaic - Landgate 2008).

## 3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

#### Comments

The application is to increase the size of clearing, under clearing permit CPS 4842/1, by 1.5 hectares to a total of 11.5 hectares, for the addition of an access road and turning lanes within the Warlu Way road reserve, Cooya Pooya.

A review of current environmental information reveals no additional information. Therefore, the assessment against the clearing principles has not changed and can be found in the Clearing Permit Decision Report CPS 4842/1.

## Planning instrument, Native Title, Previous EPA decision or other matter.

#### Comments

The application is to clear up to 11.5 hectares of native vegetation for the purpose of constructing a Solid and Liquid Waste Handling Facility, access road and turning lanes.

Main Roads Western Australia has provided approval for the works within the Karratha Tom Price Road reserve (MRWA 2013).
