Ownership of land

If granted, the permit will be issued in the name of the landowner (or applicant if acting on behalf of the landowner).

A landowner can be:

- · a person who holds the Certificate of Title
- . a person who is the lesses of Crown land, or
- a public authority that is responsible for care of the land
