### **LAND ON WHICH CLEARING IS TO BE DONE**

Victoria Location 11554 (NANSON 6532)

### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

1. Clearing of up to 1 hectare of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 503/1.

### **CONDITIONS**

1. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation within the area cross-hatched red on attached plan 503/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall not cause or permit the discharge of stormwater from the area cross-hatched yellow on attached plan 503/1 into the area cross-hatched red on attached plan 503/1.
3. Prior to clearing, the Permit Holder shall mark the boundary of the area cross-hatched yellow on attached plan 503/1 using stakes and fluorescent flagging tape on the ground.
4. The Permit Holder shall collect and store 4kg of propagative material, including seeds, of equal quantities from Casuarinaceae, Mimosaceae, Melaleuca, Papilionaceae, Poaceae and Proteaceae families from within a 10km radius of the area under application by 2 March 2011 for future rehabilitation works on the property.
5. The Permit Holder shall remove and stockpile the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this permit.
6. The Permit Holder shall remove rubbish and car bodies above the ground from within the area cross-hatched green on attached plan 503/1.
7. The Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill plant species that are not native vegetation prior to the commencement of revegetation activities within the area cross-hatched green on attached plan 503/1 and annually thereafter until 2 March 2008.
8. After completing the works required under conditions 5 and 6 and 7, the Permit Holder shall, within the area cross-hatched green on attached plan 503/1:
  - a) Lay the topsoil retained under condition 5 of this permit; and
  - b) Lay the vegetative material retained under condition 5 of this permit to an even depth on the soil as brushing material.
9. The Permit Holder shall complete the works required under conditions 5,6,7 and 8 by 2 March 2011.
