The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purpose of intersection widening and drainage modification.

2. Land on which clearing is to be done

Karnup Road reserves (PIN 11607497 and PIN 11607496), Baldivis
Young Road reserve (PIN 11607498), Baldivis

3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.02 hectares of native vegetation within the areas hatched yellow on attached Plan 5084/1.

4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

5. Type of clearing authorised

This Permit authorises the Permit Holder to clear native vegetation for the activities described in condition #1 of this Permit to the extent that the Permit Holder has the power to carry out works involving clearing for those activities under the *Local Government Act 1995* or any other written law.

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3. Assessment of application against clearing principles, planning instruments and other relevant matters

Comments Consideration has been given to impacts to biodiversity, significant fauna habitat, rare flora, threatened ecological communities, remnant vegetation values, wetlands, watercourses, land degradation, surface water quality, groundwater quality, and flooding. The assessment has found that the clearing under application is not likely to be at variance to all clearing principles.

The clearing is for the purpose of intersection widening and drainage modification. No submissions have been received.
