Environmental Protection Act 1986 s 51E

# FORM C2

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

## Purpose of clearing

Construction of new buildings, oval and hard courts and associated parking for new primary school. The site for these buildings sits relatively low compared to the proposed surrounding roads.
