Clearing of nat ive veg etation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Proposed method of clearing

Chain the area with 2 bulldozers then stick rake into mounds for burning. Smaller areas for the pump stations will be cleared with a bull dozer.

Period within which clearing is proposed to be undertaken, e.g. May 2010-June 2010

Purpose of clearing

The farming land will be cleared to develop irrigation channels, roads and irrigated farms to grow tree crops and some broad acre crops.

The pump station sites will be cleared to establish pumping facilities to lift water from the Ord River into irrigation channels for gravity feeding to the farm.

Part 3 Applicant

To apply for a permit you must either be:

- · the landowner:
- · acting on the landowner's behalf;
- · likely to become the landowner.

Note: If you are acting on behalf of the landowner, you must attach a letter of authority from the landowner explicitly stating that you, the applicant, has authority to clear on the said land.
