	For Spotted Quoll and Flying Foxing mining operations, small-scale incidental clearing may be required for maintenance and upgrades of these support services. Exploration and feasibility studies are ongoing for the New Morning resource which extends into the southern portion of this permit area.							
	WSA regularly engages specialist botanists and ecologists to undertake targeted reconnaissance surveys of flora, fauna, and habitat of areas where non-incidental clearing activities are proposed to occur to avoid and minimise impact to the environmental values of the area.							
	The WSA Clearing Permit procedure ensures the proposed clearing is surveyed and marked out prior to clearing including topsoil stockpile allocated areas to avoid potential unintended clearing. Disturbed land areas no longer being utilised will be rehabilitated in accordance with the MCP criteria.
