Purpose of clearing

Currently the ground cover is weed infested and ignored. Twice a year the Shire sprays roundup to kill all vegetation as well. We are proposing to work alongside the Shire to plant a "panorama" of the 6 Noongar seasons along our road frontage instead of letting it grow out of control. This will also allow us to ask the Shire to stop spraying along our frontage.
