	 The application to amend CPS 5648/1 is to increase the current disturbance permit from 14 ha to 40 ha in total on the basis of PoW Application ID: 73779 requires native vegetation clearing of 26.412 ha to be established by the use of a grader to provide access grid lines and drilling pads to be cut off the existing reconnaissance RC drill access track that was constructed by grading works in 2014. Grid line access is need for shallow vertical hole RC resource definition drilling at 100m x 100m centers for the calcrete areas mapped to date on E69/3065. The boundaries of permit CPS 5648/1 are to be redescribed so as to coincide with the current boundaries of E69/3065. The duration of the clearing permit is also requested to be extended for another 5 years beyond its current expiry date of 24 August 2018.
