Proposed changes:

- Increase the proposed total area to be cleared from 3.4 hectares to 13.9 hectares aligning it with EMRC's referral under the EPBC Act with Department of the Environment (EPBC Ref: 2014/7354).
- Amend the proposed offset area from 13.9 hectares to 52.5 hectares as per EMRC's Offset Proposal (see attachments). The Offset Proposal has been prepared to meet both DoTE and DER requirements.
- Amend the need to have the conservation covenant completely in place before any clearing can be undertaken. This can be achieved by amending Condition 2(a) such that the process of placing the entire offset area (52.5ha) under a conservation covenant will begin within one month of clearing activities but have finalisation within 12 months acknowledging that it will take time for the covenant to be formalised with Landgate. This condition has also been requested as part of EMRC's referral application with DoTE (see attached EMRC's Offset Proposal).
