



# Application for a clearing permit (purpose permit)

Environmental Protection Act 1986 s 51E

## FORM C2

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Purpose of clearing

The widening of the North West Coastal Highway between SLK 620.5 (Minilya-Exmouth Rd) & 767.4 (Yannarie River) from 6.2m - 10m and the re-establishment of the maintenance zone. Clearing will also be conducted for the establishment of Material Pits, culverts and bores associated with this project. (Location Maps & Shape files provided).

N.B. - Due to the nature of the distances involved with this project, 4 potential camp sites have been identified & included however we will utilise fewer than this. This assessment has been calculated on a 'worst case' scenario and is expected to be less than estimated.

### Part 3 Applicant

- have the authority of the landowner to access the land and undertake the clearing.

If granted, the permit will be issued in the name of the applicant.
