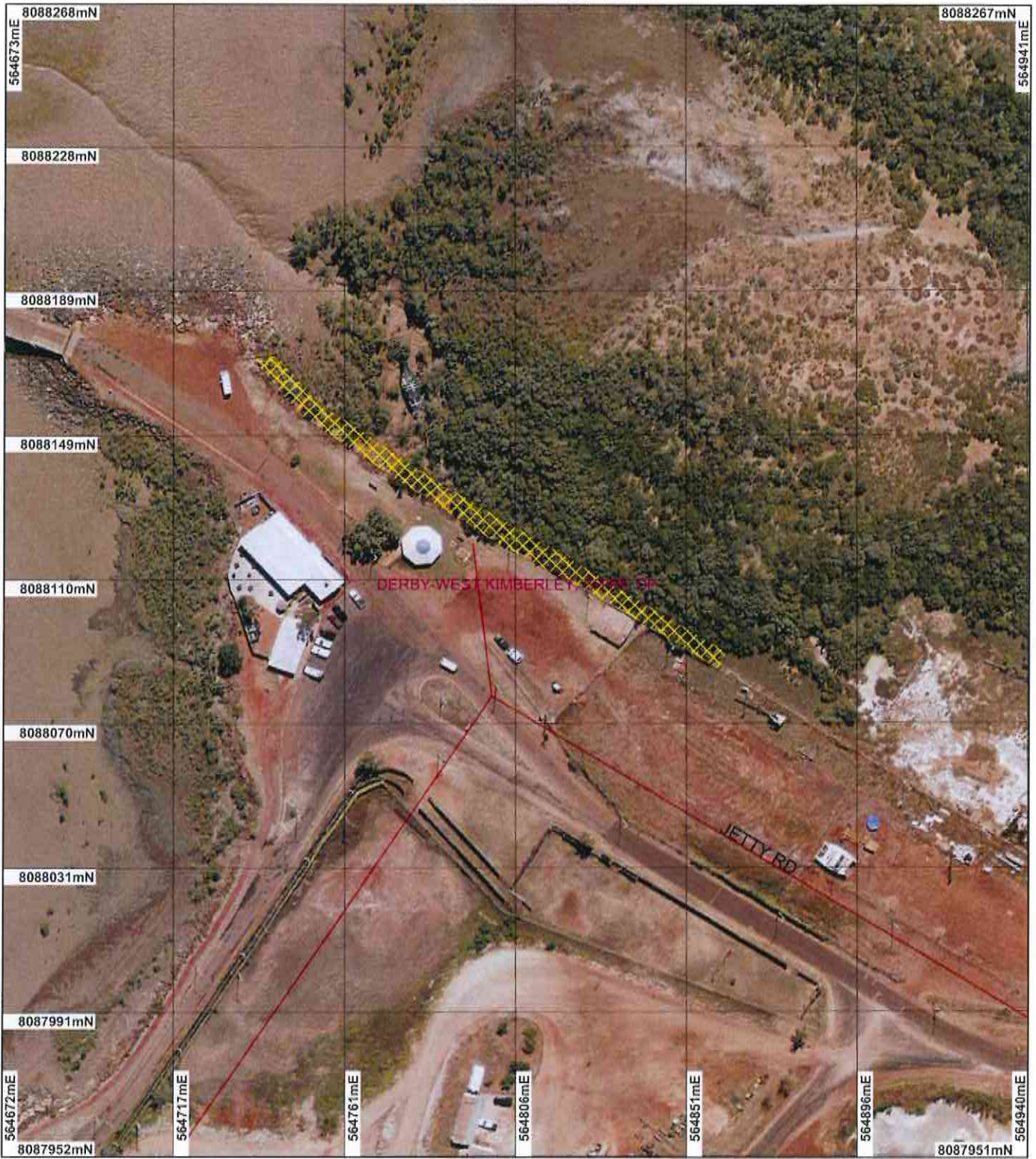

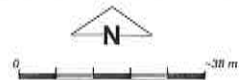

3. Assessment of application against Clearing Principles

Comments

The clearing is for the purpose of reinstating rock armour on Derby wharf.

Consideration has been given to impacts to biodiversity, significant fauna habitat, rare flora, threatened ecological communities, remnant vegetation values, wetlands, watercourses, land degradation, surface water quality, groundwater quality, and flooding.

The assessment has found that the clearing under application is not likely to be at variance to the clearing principles.
