Proposed method of clearing

Some vegetation will be covered with soil, whilst one small area is to be cleared using a machine. Also inadvertent damage from machinery operating within a difficult site.

Period within which clearing is proposed to be undertaken, e.g. May 2010–June 2010  
October 2013 (once permits are received) - June 2015

Purpose of clearing

The site in question currently has multiple badly eroded and braided 4WD tracks. This project aims to formalise and stabilise a single track into this popular coastal site, whilst closing and rehabilitating the remaining unrequired tracks. These tracks will be rehabilitated with a diversity of plant species grown from seed collected from this reserve. 80m sq of clearing is required to build suitable water bars off the track. A small area will be cleared to allow for sustainable track alignment. Vegetation along edges of track may be inadvertently impacted on during construction phase. 64m sq of clearing is required for a turnaround point at the top of the hill, both during construction phase and afterwards.

### Part 3 Applicant

To apply for a permit you must either be:

- the landowner, or
- have the authority of the landowner to access the land and undertake the clearing.

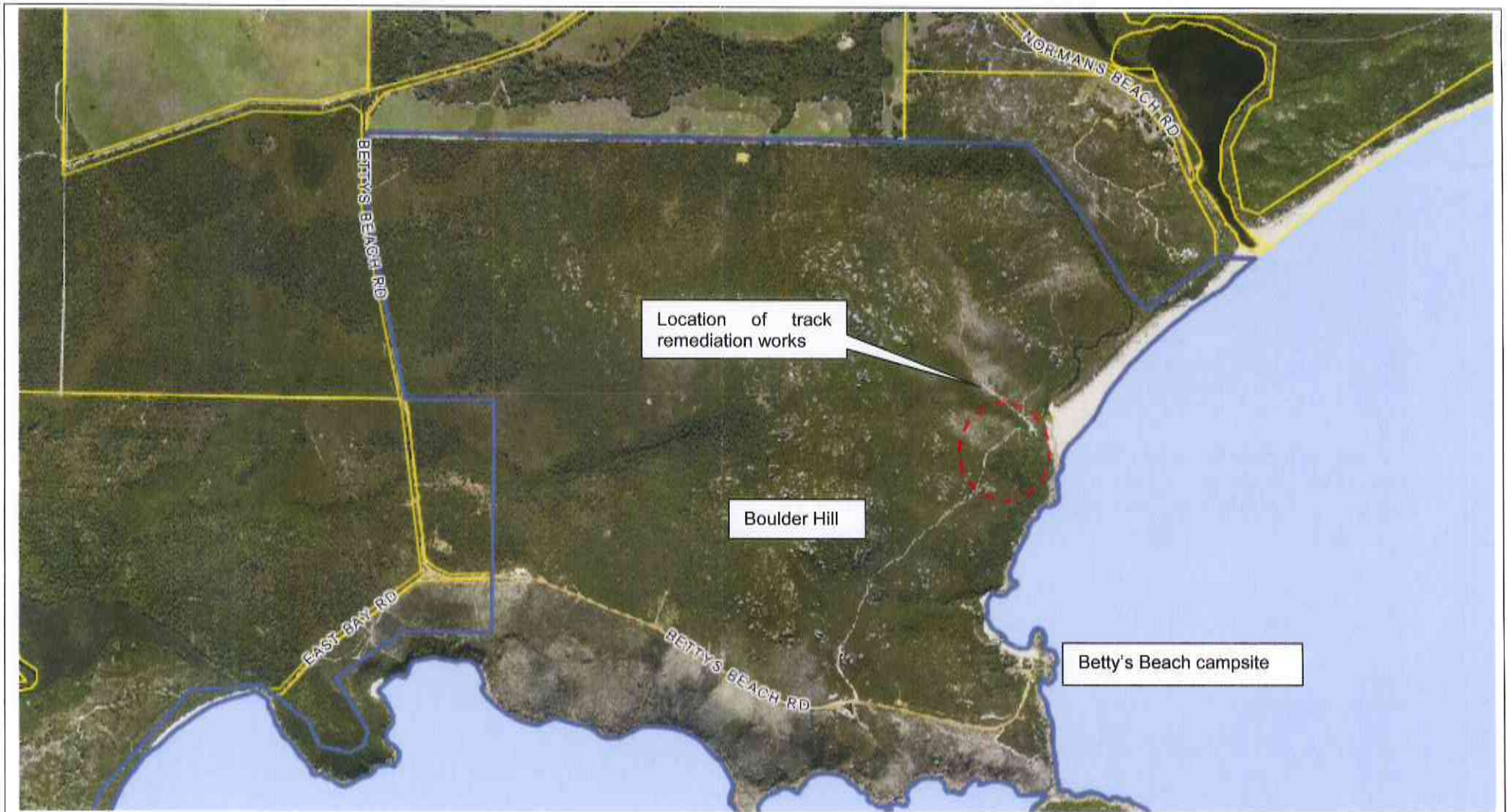
