Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Part 2 Proposal

Proposed method of clearing

The cable is to be ploughed directly into the ground. The plough slot will be 300mm wide x 1.2m deep. The machinery to do this is 2.5m wide, requiring a 3m wide clearance. *shapefile 12.6ha*

Period within which clearing is proposed to be undertaken, e.g. May 2010–June 2010

Oct - Dec 2013

Purpose of clearing

Optus proposes to install optical cable in the Old Coast Road - road reserve. The cable is to extend the optic fibre capacity to the south west of W.A. The cable is approximately 12mm in diameter and will be buried at 1.2m depth. The cable will be viable for approximately 25 years.

The cable is to be ploughed in by machinery, which is 2.5m wide, necessitating a 3m wide impact to the road reserve.

Where endangered plant species have been identified, the section will be under bored. Under boring can be done for approximately 140m, before a new bore hole is required. Bore holes to be placed where there is no effect on endangered plants.

Part 3 Applicant

To apply for a permit you must either be:

- the landowner; or
- have the authority of the landowner to access the land and undertake the clearing.

If granted, the permit will be issued in the name of the applicant.
