Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Vegetation will be cleared for the purpose of mineral production and for necessary infrastructure to facilitate mineral production such as access roads.
