Application for an amendment to a clearing permit

Environmental Protection Act 1986 section 51M

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

The permitted area of clearing is requested to be increased by 40 ha to a total of 380.89 ha to allow for the construction of the road, bund and borrow pit.</p> <p>The vegetation of the extension to the permit area is similar to that in the existing permit and composed of the same vegetation communities. Impacts will not differ significantly to the existing permit other than the increase in area.</p> <p>Three figures are attached to support the application, along with shape files of the proposed permit area in GDA94 Latitude Longitude format: Figure 1 shows the proposed permit boundary and underlying tenement M 39/1116 Figure 2 shows the proposed area in detail, the existing permit extent, and indicative location of additional clearing.
