|   | It is proposed to increase the purpose permit area to 919.2 ha to establish a TSF perimeter road and flood diversion to the east of the CTD TSF and a borrow pit to facilitate continued mining activities.<br>The boundary of the permit area is to be extended North to the boundary of tenement M 39/1116 as shown in Figure 1 to allow this. The permitted area of clearing is requested to be increased by 40 ha to a total of 380.89 ha to allow for the construction of the road, bund and borrow pit.<br>The vegetation of the extension to the permit area is similar to that in the existing perm and composed of the same vegetation communities. Impacts will not differ significant to the existing permit other than the increase in area.<br>Three figures are attached to support the application, along with shape files of the proposed permit area in GDA94 Latitude Longitude format:<br>Figure 1 shows the proposed permit boundary and underlying tenement M 39/1116<br>Figure 2 shows the proposed area in detail, the existing permit extent, and indicative location of additional clearing. |  |  |
