Third parties may also appeal against the issue of this permit. **Please note that clearing must not commence until the date stated on the permit (15 February 2014) or until notified on the outcome of any appeal. In addition, clearing must not commence until all other environmental approvals have been obtained.**

Under Condition 9 of your permit to clear native vegetation, you are required to submit an annual clearing report. This clearing report should be forwarded to the Director Operations, Environment, prior to the due date.

Compliance with the terms, conditions or restrictions of this permit does not absolve the Permit Holder from responsibility for compliance with the requirements of all Commonwealth and State legislation.
