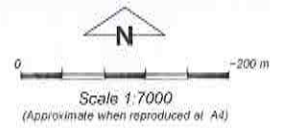

2.1. Existing environment and information

2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

Vegetation Description

Mapped Beard Vegetation Association 3 is described as medium forest; jarrah-marri (Shepherd et al 2001).

Vegetation Condition

Completely Degraded: No longer intact; completely/almost completely without native species (Keighery 1994)

3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

Comments The application is to clear 18 trees for the purpose of maintaining a motorcycle track.

Consideration has been given to impacts to biodiversity, significant fauna habitat, rare flora, threatened ecological communities, remnant vegetation values, wetlands, watercourses, land degradation, surface water quality, groundwater quality, and flooding. The assessment has found that the clearing under application may be at variance to principle (b) and is not likely to be at variance to any of the remaining clearing principles.

A site inspection of the application area (DER, 2014) identified a large Eucalypt containing a hollow suitable for conservation significant black cockatoo breeding. Inspecting the identified hollow for the presence of breeding individuals or fledgelings prior to clearing, will reduce the potential impact to these species.

No submissions have been received for this application to clear.
