To remove more rows of scrub to allow for larger machinery.

With the present permit the remaining rows are still too close together.

This makes it inefficient to crop. As there will be a lot of overlapping.

Removing the rows will stop doubling up on fertilizer and chemicals.

The remaining rows are of little value as the livestock have eaten out the undergrowth. They were originally left as wind breaks but with modern cropping practice (knife points and stubble retention) they are not necessary.

We plan to fence off the larger areas of native ~~land~~ bush (marked on the map*) so livestock can not have access, which they do at present.
