Purpose of clearing

The vegetation to be cleared is primarily made up of Sydney Golden Wattle (SGW) with only between 10 - 20 small dying Jarrah trees. There is currently a significant control program in the Wellstead area to remove SGW and as a responsible landholder I would like to contribute to this program. The area cleared will be either topped with clay and put to pasture/cropping or re-vegetated where practical. I have already received assistance from the project by a work team clearing SGW from the other high value remnant vegetation.
