To provide minimum sight lines for property egress for commercial vehicles.

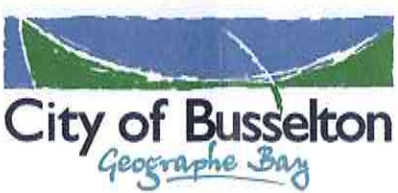
