Granted under section 51E of the Environmental Protection Act 1986

The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purposes of constructing roads, road infrastructure, car parks, paths and drainage, drainage relocation, upgrading infrastructure assets and constructing a community centre.

3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder shall not clear more than 0.19 hectares of native vegetation and 23 native trees and shrubs within the combined areas shaded yellow on attached Plan 6073/2a, Plan 6073/2b, Plan 6073/2c, Plan 6073/2d, Plan 6073/2e, Plan 6073/2f and Plan 6073/2g.

4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

5. Type of clearing authorised

This Permit authorises the Permit Holder to clear native vegetation for the activities described in condition 1 of this Permit to the extent that the Permit Holder has the power to carry out works involving clearing for those activities under the *Local Government Act 1995* or any other written law.





2.1. Existing environment and information

2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

Vegetation Description

Mapped Beard vegetation association 949 is described as low woodland; banksia (Shepherd et al 2001).

Mapped Beard vegetation association 6 is described as medium woodland; tuart & jarrah (Shepherd et al 2001).

Vegetation Condition

Good: Structure significantly altered by multiple disturbance; retains basic structure/ability to regenerate (Keighery 1994)

To

Completely Degraded: No longer intact; completely/almost completely without native species (Keighery 1994)

3. Assessment of application against clearing principles, planning instruments and other relevant matters

Comments

The application is to clear a total of 0.19 hectares of native vegetation and 23 native trees within:

- Luisin Park, Wangara, for the purpose of drainage construction
- Hidden Valley Park, Clarkson, for the purpose of drainage relocation
- Westport Parade, Darch, for the purpose of road infrastructure construction
- Neaves Road, Mariginup, and Neaves Road, Melaleuca, for the purpose of road construction.
- Lot 9335 on Deposited Plan 11143 Reserve 33504, Koondoola, for the construction of a community centre
- Lot 501 on Deposited Plan 57658 Reserve 45553, Clarkson, for upgrading infrastructure assets

Consideration has been given to impacts to biodiversity, significant fauna habitat, rare flora, threatened ecological communities, remnant vegetation values, wetlands, watercourses, land degradation, surface water quality, groundwater quality, and flooding. The assessment has found that the clearing under application is not likely to be at variance to any of the remaining clearing principles.

No submissions have been received for this application to clear.
