Granted under section 51E of the Environmental Protection Act 1986

Purpose Permit number: CPS 6073/3

The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purposes of constructing roads, road infrastructure, car parks, paths and drainage, drainage relocation, upgrading infrastructure assets and constructing a community centre.

2. Land on which clearing is to be done

Lot 555 on Deposited Plan 402197, Wanneroo Lot 9335 on Plan 11143, Reserve 33504, Koondoola Lot 501 on Deposited Plan 57658, Clarkson Lot 9619 on Plan 11776, Wangara Lot 5607 on Deposited Plan 208673, State Forest 65, Pinjar Neaves Road reserve (PIN 11751062), Mariginiup Neaves Road reserve (PIN 11543292), Melaleuca

Westport Parade road reserve (PIN 11561160), Darch Binstead Court road reserve (PIN 1389060), Koondoola

3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder shall not clear more than 0.21 hectares of native vegetation and 23 native trees and shrubs within the combined areas shaded yellow on attached Plan 6073/3a, Plan 6073/3b, Plan 6073/3c, Plan 6073/3d, Plan 6073/3f, Plan 6073/3f, Plan 6073/3g and Plan 6073/3h.

4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

5. Type of clearing authorised

This Permit authorises the Permit Holder to clear native vegetation for the activities described in condition 1 of this Permit to the extent that the Permit Holder has the power to carry out works involving clearing for those activities under the *Local Government Act 1995* or any other written law.





2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

Mapped Beard vegetation association 6 is described as medium woodland; tuart & jarrah (Shepherd et al. 2001).

Clearing Description The amended application is for the clearing of 0.21 hectares and 23 native trees within various lots and road reserves within the City of Wanneroo for the purposes of constructing roads, road infrastructure, car parks, paths and drainage, drainage relocation, upgrading infrastructure assets and

constructing a community centre.

Vegetation Condition

Good: Structure significantly altered by multiple disturbance; retains basic structure/ability to regenerate (Keighery 1994)

Completely Degraded: No longer intact; completely/almost completely without native species (Keighery 1994).

Comment

The condition of the vegetation was determined by aerial imagery.

3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

This amendment has been made to increase the clearing area by 0.02 hectares for the purpose of constructing a footpath.
