The remaining disturbance was conducted in accordance with prescribed clearing requirements for mineral activities under Regulation 5, Item 20 ('10ha rule') of the *Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Regulations 2004*. This includes 12.65 ha of mining disturbance across four tenements and 5.75 ha of drilling disturbance across four tenements. A summary of clearing conducted under the 10 ha rule is displayed in **Table 2**.




Figure 1 - FY23 Clearing under CPS 9434/1 and 10ha rule on M 16/548
