

	<p>Purpose of clearing</p> <p>Two water tanks (6m x 3m) and a pump station are to be built on Mount Adelaide to provide an independent water source for fire fighting requirements for the new National Anzac Centre. It has been recommended by FESA that a Building Protection Zone of 20m (maximum) be parkland cleared around the zincalume tanks and pump station. Due to the existing cleared zones of the parade ground, clearing is only required on the eastern side.</p>
