The City would appreciate the Department's approval to extend this clearing permit for an additional five years until September 2025 to allow sufficient time to obtain approval for the northern portion of the road reserve and address any conditions of approval through the EPA process. Request to slightly amend the size of the existing permit: A review of the southern portion of the proposed Garden Street was undertaken and it noted that seven additional native trees (3 x Allocasuarina fraseriana, 3 x Eucalyptus todtiana and 1 x Melaleuca preissiana) occur within the future Garden Street extension footprint between Balfour Street and Southern River Road. It is therefore requested that these trees be included in the amended clearing permit. The additional trees requested to be included in the amended clearing permit can be seen in Figure 1 and in the photos appended to the application. The remainder of trees within the southern extension footprint are planted trees and not considered native vegetation. Recent photos of the Melaleuca Woodland that forms part of the granted clearing permit have been included. These photos show the woodland is severely disturbed and dominated by weeds. The original clearing permit (attached) was for clearing 0.275 ha of native vegetation (degraded Melaleuca Woodland), and the amended clearing permit application is for clearing 0.297 ha of native vegetation as shown in Figure 1 and the attached shapefile. The original clearing permit boundary has been revised to more accurately reflect the boundaries of the degraded Melaleuca Woodland and has cut out the cleared areas of land. The proposed method of clearing for the proposal will be mechanical removal. The final land use will be a road and the proposed period that clearing will take place will be once EPA approval is granted for the northern portion of the Garden Street extension alignment (a few years away).
