### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

1. Clearing of up to 33.78 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 622/1a and Plan 622/1b.

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. In this Permit, cleared site means the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 622/1a and Plan 622/1b.
- 2 The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
- 3. The Permit Holder shall take the following measures within the cleared site:
  - a) Remove all rubbish and artificial debris;
  - b) Spread overburden to an even depth;
  - c) Lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained under condition 1 of this permit to an even depth on exposed overburden and soil; and
  - d) Deep rip the soil to a depth of between 50cm and 100cm.
- 4. After completing the works required under condition 3, the Permit Holder shall take the following measures:
  - a) Selectively remove or kill all plant species that are not native within the cleared site;
  - b) Sow the cleared site with a seed mixture consisting of local native species found within a 10km radius of the site. The seed mixture shall be spread at a minimum rate of 3 kilograms per hectare.
- 5. The Permit Holder shall complete the site preparation and seeding required under condition 3 and 4 by 31 September 2009.
- 6. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
  - a) The area cleared in hectares;
  - b) The area seeded in hectares under condition 4;
  - c) The species used in the seed mixture under condition 4; and
  - d) The seed rate applied in kilograms per hectare under condition 4.
- 7. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the CEO by 30 April annually setting out the records required under condition 6 of this permit, in relation to clearing carried out between 1 January and 31 December of the previous year.
