Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Purpose of clearing

The Mitchell Freeway provides the primary road access route from the Perth north-west corridor towards the City of Perth. The freeway currently terminates at Burns Beach Road. The freeway has been constructed in several stages since the 1960s, with further extensions and widening works planned. Further development of the freeway is now required to provide a more direct route for traffic in the far northern suburbs, take pressure off smaller local roads and facilitate residential and business development in the area.

The Project includes the proposed extension of Mitchell Freeway from Burns Beach Road to Hester Avenue. The Project is mostly located in the City of Wanneroo with works on Joondalup Drive and Burns beach Road located within the City of Joondalup. The proposed road design is located within the Metropolitan Region Scheme boundary.
