Purpose of clearing

- 1. Great Southern Highway, York (Corner of Ovens Rd)
This project is a State funded Black Spot location and requires action. Vegetation on the east side of the Great Southern Highway is reducing sight distance to the south from the Ovens Rd junction to below standard. The removal of trees and vegetation to the south in accordance with AustRoads intersections at grade and Australian standards has been recommended by a Road Safety Audit (attached).
- 2. Berrybrow Rd, York (300m from Great Southern Highway)
The Shire of York has received a request from a school bus operator to reduce vegetation to improve sight-line distances and reduce crash risk. The area has been marked for declared rare flora. The Department of Parks and Wildlife will be consulted on the presence and potential removal of *Lechenaultia laricina* in this location.
