# Application for a clearing permit (purpose permit)

Environmental Protection Act 1986 s 51E

## FORM C2

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Excavation of an inlet by an excavator.

Period within which clearing is proposed to be undertaken, e.g. May 2013 – June 2018

Between January 27 and February 27 2015 – during the dropping of Lake Kununurra water levels by the Water Corporation to conduct annual maintenance. Clearing will take approx. hour.

Purpose of clearing

To create two small inlets (8m wide by 15m long) on a commercial boats site, to house two commercial houseboats. These inlets are a requirement of the Water Corporation, to ensure that large vessels are not stored in the main body of the river, to minimise the risk of vessels moving downstream during high volume flow events and damaging infrastructure. As a part of the excavation several small patches of Cabungi will need to be removed. No other riparian or fringing vegetation will be impacted.
