Main Roads Western Australia (MRWA) is proposing to grade separate three intersections of Tonkin Highway, namely Benara Road, Morley Drive and Collier Road within the City of Bayswater, Western Australia. The project allows for the upgrading of this length of Tonkin Highway to include additional traffic lanes.

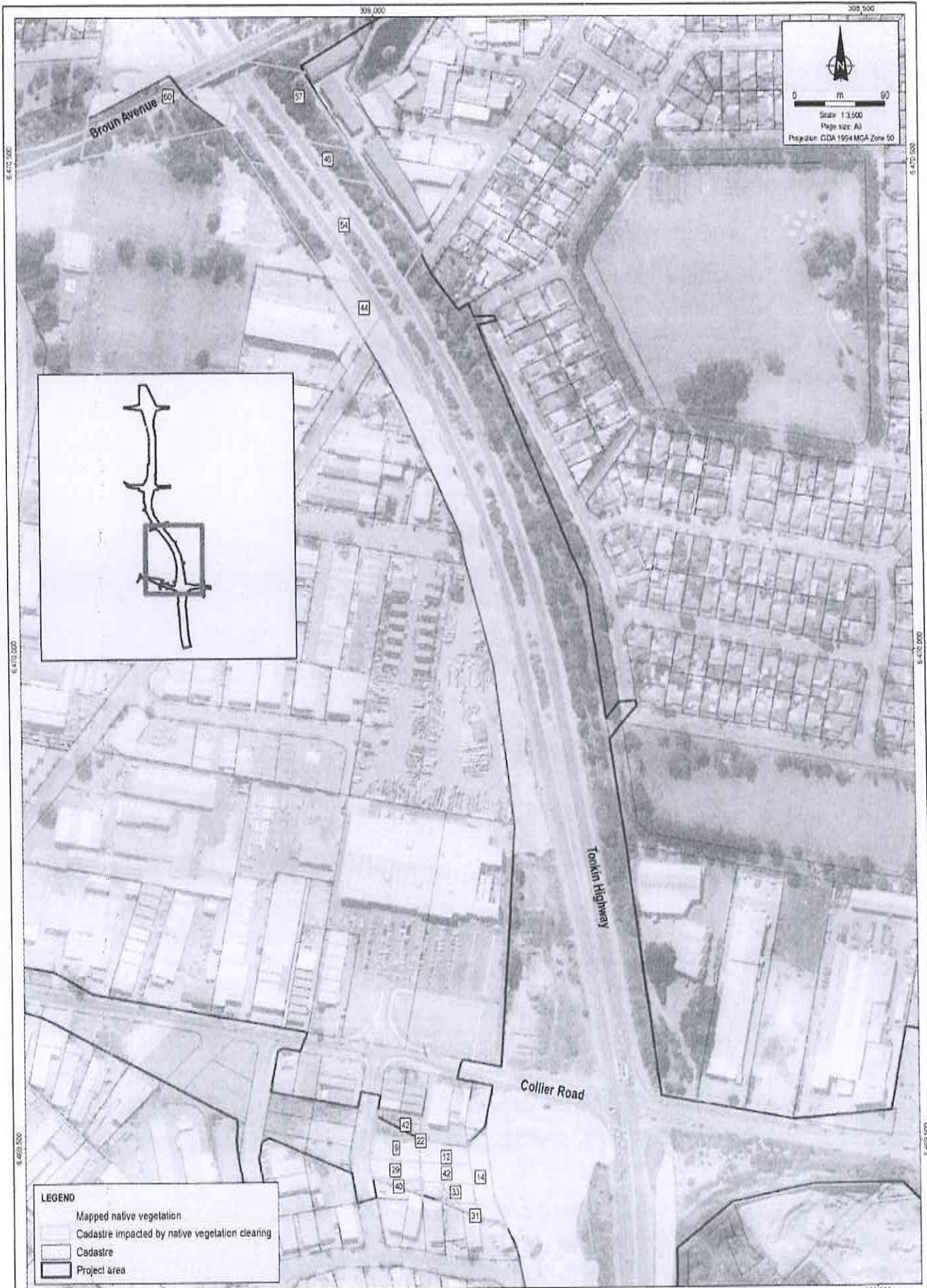
