	Additional areas of pre-dominantly re-growth vegetation and some native vegetation will require-clearing to assist with final decommissioning and rehabilitation, have been added to the CPS 6947/2. Majority of clearing is likely to be undertaken in 2022 consisting of 5.75 ha within a boundary of 16.49 ha. Well sites that have not been Plugged and Abandoned will be cleared and rehabilitated at a later date. The final land use will form part of the Unallocated Crown Land managed by DBCA. Clearing will only occur in the amended attached shape file of existing CPS 6947/2.
