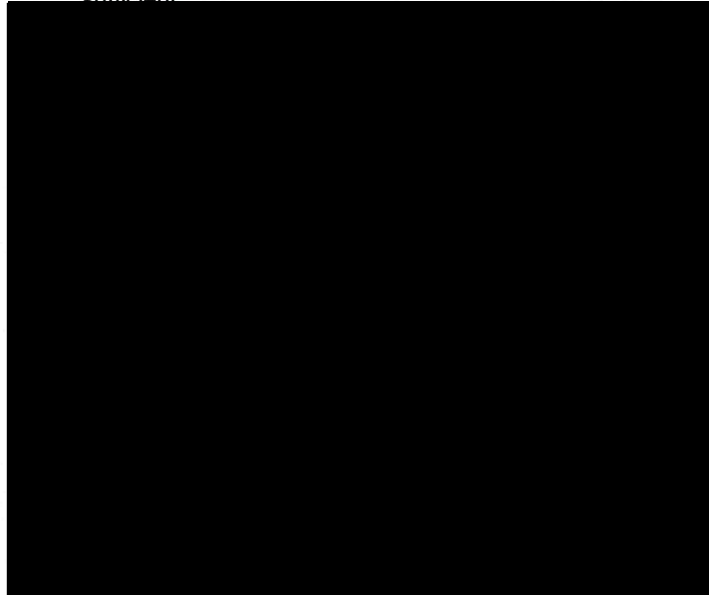

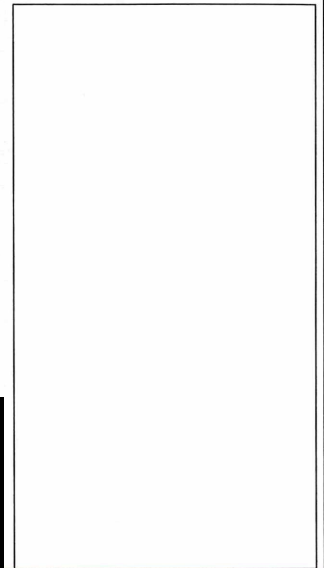

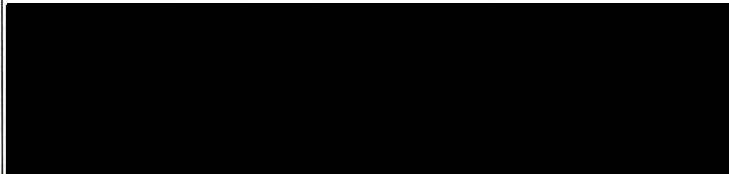

Provide details of proposed changes:

The proposed amendment is to reflect the recent tenement amalgamation where M24/290, M24/352, P24/4182 where joined to form **M24/960**. The proposed clearing is to include an addition adjacent Mining Tenement, M24/208.

The clearing is required for this amendment is to include an expansion of the Missouri Waste Landform, a 30-40 person accommodation camp, additional site infrastructure and potable water pipeline from the mine to the camp.

An additional Level 1 survey was undertaken to include the camp site and increase the clearing envelope from 149.15 ha to 203.66 ha (increase of 54.15 ha) The previous approved clearing permitted within the envelope was 66 hectares. An additional amount 30 ha of clearing is required.

This addendum seeks to bring the total amount of clearing to 96 hectares within an envelope of 203.66 Ha (crossed hatched on provided plan)
