## Additional Information for Clearing Permit Application - Cross Park

### Lot 100 Andreas Road (44 Jarrah Road), Roleystone

#### 1.0 Description of Works

The Clearing Permit is required to install 2 additional cricket practice nets at Cross Park Cricket Pavilion. The proposed design of the practice nets will minimise the impact on surrounding vegetation at the site. Attachment 1 is a location map that identifies the site and the trees proposed for removal.

Attachment 2 is a civil design drawing that illustrates the proposed works.

#### 2.0 Land Tenure

Lot 100 Andreas Road, Roleystone is zoned as Parks and Recreation under the City of Armadale Town Planning Scheme No. 4. The property is owned by the City of Armadale.



## 3.0 Vegetation

The Clearing Permit application proposes the removal of 7 trees (images below). The species include:

- 1 x Corybmia calophylla (DBH < 50cm)</li>
- 1 x Eucalyptus marginata (DBH < 50cm)</li>
- 3 x Eucalyptus sp. (DBH < 50cm)</li>
- 2 x Meleluca sp. (DBH < 50cm)</li>







## 4.0 Environmentally Sensitive Areas

A desktop analysis of the Department of Parks and Wildlife's database indicates that no Environmentally Sensitive Areas are within the proposed work site. There are however three recorded occurences of Declared Rare Fanua withing a 1km radius of the site at 232m, 761m and 977m from the proposed clearing. This is illustrated in the map below.
