June 2016 July 2017 Purpose of clearing

To allow for widening of the existing road formation width by 2 meters only (1m either side o the existing carriageway) and provide safe sightlines at curves, crests and intersections to meet current Austroads/Main Roads Standards

Clearing for sightlines at curves will be restricted to only one side of the road for two reasons one is to reduce the clearing footprint and secondly, to assist in easing/straightening of the curve to improve significes for motorists.
