1.2. Description of clearing activities

Clearing permit CPS 7348/1 was granted by the Department of Mines and Petroleum (now the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety) on 5 January 2017 and was valid from 28 January 2017 to 31 January 2022. The permit authorised the clearing of up to 21.35 hectares of native vegetation within a boundary of approximately 29.308 hectares, for the purpose of a tailings storage facility (TSF).

CPS 7348/2 was granted on 6 May 2021, amending the permit to increase the permit boundary, extend the permit duration and update the permit holder name.

The permit holder applied to surrender clearing permit CPS 7348/2 on 27 September 2024.

The application to surrender the clearing permit has been made as the Mt Dimer Project and relevant tenure was acquired by Beacon Mining Pty Ltd (Aurumin, 2024).

1.4. Reasons for decision

In making the decision, the Delegated Officer had regard for:

- a review of the permit holder's compliance with conditions of clearing permit CPS 6326/2 (Section 2.1)
- other matters considered relevant to the decision (Section 2.2).

The application to surrender was submitted, accepted and determined in accordance with section 51MA of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

After consideration of the above information, the Delegated Officer decided to accept the surrender of clearing permit CPS 7348/2.

2 Assessment of surrender

2.1. Review of compliance with clearing permit conditions

On 5 November 2024, the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (the department) reviewed the annual clearing reports for clearing permit CPS 7348/2. The department identified that the permit holder had cleared approximately 1.76 hectares of native vegetation from 5 April 2017 to 16 May 2017 (Aurumin, 2023; Beacon, 2024; Golden Iron, 2017).

A review of aerial imagery and shapefiles provided by the Permit Holder showed that 1.63 hectares of this clearing was outside of the clearing permit boundary. This clearing outside of the permit boundary was undertaken in order to meet the requirements of the Direction to Modify (DTM) issued by the department under the *Mining Act 1978* on 17 August 2016 (DMP, 2016). The DTM required the Permit Holder to rectify tailings that had migrated out of the tailings storage facility (TSF) and restore it back into the TSF. A DTM Completion Report was submitted to the department in July 2017 and the requirements of the DTM were determined to be complete, therefore the department closed the DTM on 9 August 2017 (DMP, 2017; Povey, 2017).

In addition, an inspection of the clearing permit CPS 7348/1 was conducted on 5 April 2018 as a result of the DTM, and the inspection determined that no further action was required under Part V Division 2 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (DMIRS, 2018).

The department's review of the permit holder's requirements under clearing permit CPS 7348/2 did not identify any other non-compliance with the clearing permit conditions (Table 1).

The permit holder submitted annual clearing permit reports in 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. These reports included the records required under Condition 8 of this Permit (Aurumin, 2021; Aurumin, 2022; Aurumin, 2023; Beacon, 2024; Golden Iron, 2017). The permit holder confirmed that in all other periods under the Permit, no clearing occurred. The permit holder is compliant with this condition.

2.2. Relevant planning instruments and other matters

The received surrender application was advertised on 13 December 2024 by the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety.
