### AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 2.3 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 740/4.

### CONDITIONS

1. The Permit holder shall construct a fence enclosing the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 740/4. The fence shall be constructed and maintained so as to be adequate to exclude public access. Construction of the fence shall be completed by 31 December 2006.
2. The permit holder shall establish and maintain native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow in accordance with the following conditions:
  - (a) prior to revegetation, the area cross hatched yellow shall be contoured to realign with the existing dune system;
  - (b) native vegetation cleared from the area cross hatched yellow shall be mulched for the purpose of assisting in revegetation by providing a source of seeds, minimising wind erosion and to provide habitat value;
  - (c) plant species to be used shall consist of overstorey, middle storey and understorey species that are native to the area;
  - (d) revegetation shall be established and maintained to an average planting density of 10 000 plants per hectare; and
  - (e) revegetation is to be commenced by 2 July 2007 and completed by 29 August 2008, except for any reseeded required because of plant failure.
