	We hereby request approval to undertake clearing in July 2018 due to time constraints caused by the delay in accessing these works until this time. All vegetation has been cleared with only trees to be felled. The subject area is on a spring fed creek, not on the Four Mile Creek. Land has been contoured already thereby avoiding soil erosion from the proposed works.
