Application for a clearing permit (purpose permit)

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Part 1 Assessment under the EPBC bilateral agreement

Proposed method of clearing or final land use

Proposed construction method of the pipeline include a clear and grade process to remove the vegetation and topsoil from the construction right of way (ROW). Clear and grade will include the removal of vegetation and the grading of 100 mm of topsoil, depending on the soil profile, using bulldozers and graders. The vegetation will be pushed aside and topsoil will be separately stockpiled (in windrows) along the edge of the construction ROW to permit safe and practical construction access, whilst preserving the topsoil for later reinstatement. Operational clearing requirements will be minimal, and restricted to those areas previously cleared during construction; clearing will be predominantly for maintenance of line of sight between pipeline markers and of access tracks.
