The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

PART I - CLEARING AUTHORISED

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purpose of constructing an isolation bund and flow control structures.

2. Land on which clearing is to be done

Lot 17369 on Deposited Plan 83410, Yealering

Lot 19634 on Deposited Plan 84681 (unallocated Crown land), Yealering

Lot 19716 on Deposited Plan 85023, Yealering

Lot 19893 on Deposited Plan 85453 (Crown reserve 15672), Yealering

Lot 29612 on Deposited Plan 30829 (part Crown reserve 9610), Yealering

3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder must not clear more than 1.153 hectares of native vegetation within the area shaded yellow on attached Plan 7833/1.

4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

PART II – MANAGEMENT CONDITIONS

5. Avoid, minimise and reduce the impacts and extent of clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

PART III - RECORD KEEPING AND REPORTING

6. Records must be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, in relation to the clearing of native vegetation authorised under this Permit:

- (a) the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit set to Geocentric Datum Australia 1994 (GDA94), expressing the geographical coordinates in Eastings and Northings or decimal degrees;
- (b) the date that the area was cleared;
- (c) the size of the area cleared (in hectares); and
- (d) actions taken to avoid, minimise and reduce the impacts and extent of clearing in accordance with condition 5 of this Permit.

7. Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO the records required under condition 6 of this Permit, when requested by the CEO.
